In addition to classroom opportunities, JA offers several experiential, capstone programs that offer valuable volunteer engagement:

- JA Company Program – students create, market and operate their own company
- JA Job Shadow – prepares students to find and obtain a job
- JA Titan - online business simulation where students create and market a successful company

Volunteer Role

Classroom volunteers deliver our curriculum on a weekly basis. Classroom visits are scheduled directly with the assigned teacher, allowing for flexibility in scheduling.

Time Commitment

- Multi-visit delivery – volunteers visit the classroom on five to seven separate occasions, 45 minutes per visit
- Pre-classroom preparation is also required to familiarize the volunteer with the curriculum and organize/prepare the kit materials (approximately 5 hours)

Location

Lessons are delivered on-site at the school.
