



Fundraising doesn't have to stop on the day of your event! Now that you have a captive audience at a bowling alley, here are some easy and fun ways to keep the funds rolling in:



Live donate

JAUM now offers text to give! Text JA bigBowl to 50155 to donate. Encourage bowlers to take their phones out and make donations, especially for a last-minute push to reach (or exceed!) your goal.



Sponsor strikes

Find a bowler or supporter who will sponsor strikes. Every strike for the day earns \$.



Raffles and auctions

50/50 Raffle: Sell raffle tickets with 50% of the proceeds to JA, 50% to the winner. You can keep the 50/50 going by having the winner draw a second winner to receive 50% of their winnings and so on. The more you donate, the more you can win!

Wine Pull: Get wine donated from local liquor stores or execs in your company. Supplement with inexpensive bottles. Put all the bottles in numbered brown paper bags. Individuals pay \$10-20 (set your price based on your audience) and draw a cork with a number on it. They win the corresponding bottle. Make sure there are some more expensive bottles mixed in to keep people engaged!

Standard Raffle: Get prizes donated to raffle off at the event. Ask team captains to each contribute one item.

Live Auction: Hold a live auction at the start of the event reserved for the top 3-5 prizes.

Balloon Raffle: Roll up raffle tickets and put them in balloons. Draw your raffle ticket and have everyone pop their balloons to see who wins.

Cupcake Raffle: Sell cupcakes. One cupcake has colored filling. Hand out the cupcakes all at once and have everyone start eating. Grand prize goes to the cupcake with the colored filling...but everyone wins when they get a cupcake!
