



Virtual Simulation Tips and Tricks JA Finance Park

Preparation Checklist:

- Set up student usernames and passwords ahead of time. We recommend making the passwords as generic as possible – the same password can be used multiple times. Also, keep in mind that once you use a username you will not be able to use it again – we have found that using student ID numbers works well because they are so unique.
- Plan for the simulation to take 2–3 regular class periods or 2-3 hours; you will need 1:1 technology for the simulation.
- Provide a copy or list of usernames and passwords to the students or have them posted for each class period. Remind the students the usernames and passwords are CASE SENSITIVE as they login to their personal simulation.
- Ask for additional staff support from school administration to assist students in getting logged into the system on the first day of the simulation.
- The JA Finance Park virtual simulation is not compatible with tablets or iPads. The simulation operates best on Google Chrome.
